## Credit towards BCPA Membership Dues for Membership in a Local Piping Society

The BC Pipers' Association encourages you to support the activities of your local piping society. Within the BCPA's competition sanctioning jurisdiction there are four such local piping societies acknowledged by the BCPA:

- Kelvern Celtic Society (BC Interior)
- Vancouver Island Pipers Club (Vancouver Island)
- Washington Pipers Association (Washington state)
- Oregon Pipers Society (Oregon state)

Since 1999, in recognition of the activities these local piping societies provide, the BCPA has provided members of these four local piping societies an opportunity to credit a portion of the official annual dues paid to their local piping society toward their annual membership fee to be a BCPA Member. For the BCPA membership year 2008-2009, the credits available are as follows:

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Recognized membership in your local piping society must cover at least nine months of 2009. Credits are not given retroactively. No other local piping societies other than the four above will be acknowledged for dues credits.

For the credit to be recognized **you must provide one of the following:**

- A photocopy of your local piping society membership card showing that it covers at least nine months of 2010.

## Consent for Collection, Use and Disclosure of Personal Information

By selecting "Yes", I consent to the collection, use and disclosure of my personal information for the purposes of verifying my membership in the BC Pipers' Association (BCPA).
